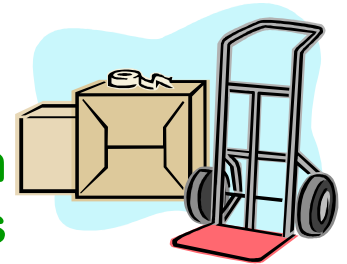
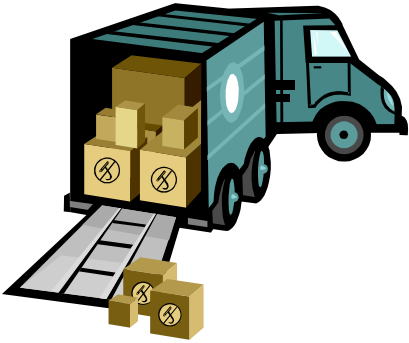

# SPRING/SUMMER Training Calendar

For over three decades Teen Corps members have stood trained and ready to respond in any function needed to assist our chapter and the Central Florida community in the event of a disaster or emergency situation. That mission has not changed; additionally one of the hallmarks of being a Teen Corps member is being able to live up to the Teen Corps motto - to be able “...to save a life anywhere, anytime, under any circumstances....” To that end, it is necessary to complete a few required training classes, CPR/AED/First Aid for starters as well as a series of Hurricane Preparedness/Response classes.

We know your schedules are filled with requirements for school, family, church and friends as well as all of the extra curricular activities that go along with being a teenager. So, to help we are going to try something a bit different with training. We are giving you a list of the required classes for all Teen Corps/Red Cross club members and a list of several classes being offered (with dates/times/locations) for you to pick from; additionally we will include some classes that may be of special interest to some of you.

Hurricane Season is fast approaching , so we are going to focus on CPR/AED/First Aid training and Basic Disaster Preparedness Training. For the rest of the spring and summer, this section of the newsletter will contain a list of classes being offered by the American Red Cross Mid-Florida Region. You’ll see the class name and number, as well as the date, time and location of the class and an email contact to register for the class; it will be up to you to pick a class that fits with your schedule. You will then email the contact person with your choice and all of the pertinent information. Once the contact person has registered you into the class you will receive an email confirmation. Once you complete the class, you make a copy of your certificate and bring it to the Youth Involvement office and we will credit your service/training hours. Sounds easy right? It is and it is flexible with your schedules - you just have to take the initiative to get plan your schedule.

We’ll put all of the classes in beginning this week, in the meantime, here’s a sample of how the information will look.....

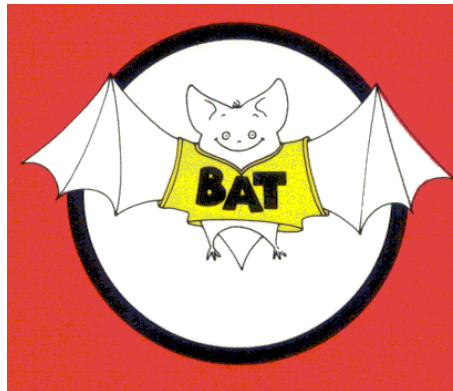
